

Pirates of the 18th century carried firing weapons similar to these non-firing flintlock pistol replicas. The original flintlocks were very popular among pirates and commonly used during raiding exploits. Such skirmishes rarely included time for reloading, so raiders often carried a cutlass to accompany the pistol. Because of its ability to fire multiple projectiles from a single powder charge, the blunderbuss became the weapon of choice for short-range encounters with the miscreants of the 17th and 18th centuries.
